# **Enhanced Security Feature at Our Front Entry**

The security features on the Front Entry doors have been changed so that only one door may be open at a time. This means when you enter or leave; the door in front of you will not open until the other door has completely closed. This security measure helps to ensure that an unescorted resident wearing a wander alert bracelet cannot exit directly behind someone leaving the building. It also means that if a resident with a bracelet enters this area, the outside door will not open unless a by-pass code is entered or the resident returns to the lounge area outside of the sensor range. At these times, staff may need come to the Front Entry to assist. This may delay your entry or exit. We ask for your patience on those occasions when you must wait for staff assistance to enter or leave the building.

Also, a reminder that you must stand **behind** the yellow line (on the door mat) after the inner entry door release function has been activated. The door will not automatically open if you are too close to this door.

# **Bus Outings – Price Increase**

Due to increased operating costs we have increased the individual fee for our various bus outings

(i.e. Mystery Drives, Tea Bus, etc). The cost will increase from \$2.00 to \$4.00 per outing. This fee is charged to resident's Comfort Fund. The new rate goes into effect on March 1<sup>st</sup>.

#### **Comfort Accounts FYI**

The purpose of the Resident

Comfort Account is to provide residents with a source from which they may withdraw petty cash and to conveniently make payments for goods/services to the resident such as:

- Non-prescription pharmacy items, foot care, dental hygiene and hairdressing services
- Guest meals
- Tuck Shop purchases & dry cleaning services
- Recreation bus outings &Taxi/Handi Dart services
- Other items that may be necessary for the care of the Resident

At various times during each month, Columbus Residence must debit funds from individual accounts to pay suppliers for these goods/services. It is therefore important that there be sufficient funds in a resident's account at the beginning of each month to cover these debits. Residents/family should review their monthly Comfort Fund statements to determine their average monthly charges and ensure that there are adequate funds in the account at the beginning of each month to cover all of that month's expenses.

### **Resident Pharmacy Invoices**

After processing through our Finance Department, all resident monthly pharmacy (and foot care) invoices are kept on file in our Front Office.

Families may pick these up at any time during our regular office hours (Mon-Fri) or alternatively you may call our Front Office and make arrangements with our staff to have these left with one of the team nurses for pick up after hours/on weekends.
