Resident Comfort Accounts...An Overview

The purpose of the Resident Comfort Account is to provide residents with a source from which they may withdraw petty cash and to conveniently make payments for goods/services to the resident such as:

- * Non prescription pharmacy items
- * Hairdressing and Foot Care services
- * Dry cleaning
- * Guest meals and Tuck Shop purchases
- * Recreation outings where an additional cost may be involved
- * Taxi/Handi Dart services

Throughout each month, Columbus Residence must withdraw money from individual comfort fund accounts to make payments to suppliers who provide goods/services to the resident. It is therefore essential that there be sufficient funds in a resident's comfort account at the <u>beginning</u> of each month to cover the costs that will be incurred during that month.

We recommend that residents/family review their monthly statements to determine their average monthly charges and ensure that there are adequate funds in the account at the beginning of each month to cover all of that month's expenses. Please do not wait until you receive your statement to pay for charges incurred in the previous month.
