Columbus LTC Society Annual General Meeting – June 29th


The Annual General Meeting of Columbus Long Term Care Society will take place on **Wednesday June 29**th at **7:00 p.m.**

- If possible, plan outdoor outings during the cooler periods of the day


Annual Wheelchair & Walker Maintenance - Scheduled for August


